**IMMEDIATE RELEASE** – Tulare County Elections Update 7/11/17 – Tulare Local Health Care District, Area 3 Special Recall Election

**NEWS MEDIA** - Tulare County Registrar of Voters, Michelle Baldwin, is releasing unofficial Election Day results for the Tulare Local Health Care District, Area 3 Special Recall Election. Our office has counted 879 ballots for the special election with 707 yes votes and 168 no votes. Senovia Gutierrez has received 569 votes, Jesse R. Salcido has received 173 votes and we received 17 write-in votes. There are 4,941 registered voters in the Area 3 district. The unofficial Election Day results can be viewed on our website [www.tularecoelections.org](http://www.tularecoelections.org) that will include vote-by-mail, all-mail precinct and processed ballots voted at the polls.

New California laws have extended the time period for counting vote by mail ballots. Any vote by mail ballot will be considered timely if the ballot is postmarked or time stamped on or before Election Day and received in our office no later than three (3) days after the Election Day.

Additionally, Election Code 3019 went into effect on January 1, 2016 and now requires the Registrar of Voters office to allow eight (8) days after an election for an unsigned vote by mail ballot to be counted if the voter comes into the office and signs the envelope ballot statement. Our office will contact the voters advising them that they have eight (8) days to sign their ballot statement.

After all of the ballots have been counted and canvass has been completed, the Registrar of Voters can then certify the election. California law requires that an election be certified and submitted to the Governing Body within thirty (30) days of the Election.

- The last day to register to vote for this election is **Monday, June 26, 2017**.

- Vote by Mail ballots will become available beginning **Monday, June 12, 2017**.
- **Wednesday, July 5, 2017** is the last day the Registrar of Voters Office may receive Vote by Mail ballot requests through the mail. Otherwise, after July 3, 2017, voters may come to the Elections Office located at Government Plaza, 5951 S. Mooney Blvd., Visalia, to request a Vote by Mail ballot in person.
- Tulare County residents that will be sworn in as a United States Citizen by a Federal Judge after **Monday, June 26, 2017**, but no later than the close of polls on Election Day, may register and vote at the Tulare County Registrar of Voters Office. You will be required to show your Naturalization Certificate at the time of registration.

BALLOT PROCESSING**

As per Elections Code 12109, notice is hereby given that at the Special Recall Election to be held on July 11, 2017, all voted ballots will be counted on either a Sequoia Insight or a Sequoia Edge (Touch Screen) voting unit at each polling location, and the results will be accumulated at the Tulare County Registrar of Voters Office after the polls close on Election Day. All valid Vote by Mail and provisional ballots will be counted at a central location on a Sequoia 400-C central count optical scan tabulation machine and not at a polling location. That central location will be at the Tulare County Registrar of Voters Office located at: 5951 S. Mooney Blvd., Visalia, California.

The polls will be open from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. on Election Day.

As per Elections Code 15104, the Registrar of Voters also hereby notifies all interested organizations that the verifying of signatures on Vote by Mail voter ballots cast for the Special Recall Election will commence on June 12, 2017, in the County Registrar of Voters Office, 5951 S. Mooney Blvd., Visalia, California. On June 27, 2017, or at any time thereafter, the opening, processing and central count accumulation of Vote by Mail ballots will commence. This process will continue until all election results are tabulated and the election is certified.

Any member of the County Grand Jury, and any other interested organization, shall be permitted to observe and challenge the manner in which the Vote by Mail voter ballots are processed, from the opening through the counting and disposition of the ballots.
