JUDICIAL, FEDERAL AND LOCAL OFFICES

- Deadline for signatures in lieu is February 7, 2018.
- **JUDGES ONLY:** The non-refundable filing fee and/or signatures in lieu must be presented at the time the candidate files a Declaration of Intent. Declaration of Intent filing period opens January 29, 2018 and closes February 7, 2018.
- The Nomination Period opens Monday, February 12, 2018 and closes Friday, March 9, 2018. **NOTE:** The Registrar of Voters office will remain open until 5:00 p.m. on Friday, March 9, 2018.
- The non-refundable filing fee and/or signatures in lieu must be presented at the time the candidate picks up the Nomination Packet during the Nomination Period.
