PRESS RELEASE - - Tulare County Registrar of Voters, Michelle Baldwin, is releasing the daily Tulare County Elections Update.

The Tulare County Registrar of Voters started the Official Canvass process of the June 7, 2022 Statewide Direct Primary Election. Final Official Tally results can be found posted on our election website www.tularecoelections.org.

We processed a total of 111 ballots for the Signature Verification Statements received for the no signature match and no signature ballots today.

Canvass activities:

- Deadline was today for the Signature Verification Statements received for the no signature match and no signature ballots.
- Completed preparing the stipend for the nearly 400 poll worker volunteers.
- Completed the $1 \%$ manual tally process.
- Completed processing the Provisional Ballots involving the review and comparison of each voter envelope to that voter's original registration affidavit and signature on record. This process is required for accuracy of the vote, to ensure each eligible vote cast is counted and to credit each voter for voting.
- Completed processing the Conditional Voter Registration Ballots.
- Completed the process of reviewing Polling Place Ballot Statements for reconciliation.
- Completed the duplication process involving ballots that were damaged, needed to be remade to enable them to be counted.
- Completed importing voting history to credit voters in EIMS.
- Completed processing undeliverable ballots in EIMS.

Upon conclusion of the Canvass process, final results will be certified that will include the tally of all votes. California Law requires that the Election be certified by July 7, 2022.
