NOTICE OF SPECIAL BOND ELECTIONS AND NOTICE OF DATE FIXED FOR SUBMITTING ARGUMENTS FOR SUNDALE UNION ELEMENTARY SCHOOL DISTRICT

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN to the qualified electors of the Sundale Union Elementary School District (the "District") located in the County of Tulare, State of California, that in accordance with the provisions of the Education Code of the State of California, an election will be held on November 8, 2022 within the School District, at which election the following measures shall be submitted to the qualified electors of the District and voted upon:

Sundale Union Elementary School District

To improve the quality of education facilities; modernize outdated classrooms, restrooms and school facilities; and construct a gymnasium for school and community use; shall Sundale Union Elementary School District's measure be adopted authorizing \$4,000,000 of bonds at legal rates, generating on average \$262,776 annually while bonds are outstanding at a rate of approximately 3 cents per \$100 assessed value, with annual audits, independent citizens' oversight committee, NO money for salaries and all money staying local?

Sundale Union Elementary School District

To improve the quality of education facilities; modernize and construct classrooms, restrooms and school facilities; improve technology; and make health, safety and handicapped accessibility improvements; shall Sundale Union Elementary School District's measure be adopted authorizing \$3,800,000 of bonds at legal rates, generating on average \$249,600 annually while bonds are outstanding at a rate of approximately 3 cents for \$100 assessed value, with annual audits, independent citizens' oversight committee, NO money for salaries and all money staying local?

The above proposition shall become effective if 55% of the votes cast approve the proposition.

All of the purposes enumerated in the foregoing measure shall be united and voted upon as one single measure, with precincts, places of holding the elections and officers appointed to conduct the elections to be the

same as those provided for the General Election to be held on November 8, 2022.

The bonds proposed to be issued and sold shall bear interest at a rate not exceeding twelve percent (12%) per annum.

The number of years the whole or any part of the bonds are to run shall not exceed the statutory maximum, which is twenty-five (25) years in the case of bonds issued under the authority of the Education Code and forty (40) years in the case of bonds issued under the authority of the Government Code, from the date of the bonds or the date of any series thereof.

This election has been called pursuant to a Resolution of the Governing Board of the Sundale Union Elementary School District, adopted on June 21, 2022.

The Elections Official of the County of Tulare hereby gives formal notice of the election in accordance with the provisions of Education Code Section 15120.

Arguments for or against this measure may be submitted to the Tulare County Registrar of Voters Office, 5951 South Mooney Blvd, Visalia, CA 93277 no later than August 2, 2022 which has been determined by the elections official to be a reasonable date based upon the time necessary to prepare and print arguments. No argument shall exceed 300 words in length.

Pursuant to Section 9501 of the Elections Code, one argument for and one argument against this measure will be selected for printing and distribution to the voters with the sample ballot.

The elections official will also provide opportunity for rebuttal arguments to be filed no later than August 12, 2022 in accordance with Section 9504 of the Elections Code.

The polls will be open Election Day between 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.
