NOTICE OF BUSINESS TAX ELECTION AND NOTICE OF DATE FIXED FOR SUBMITTING ARGUMENTS FOR THE CITY OF EXETER.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN to the qualified electors of the City of Exeter located in the County of Tulare, State of California, that in accordance with law, an election will be held on Tuesday, the 8th day of November, 2022, for the purpose of submitting for approval or rejection the following measure, to be displayed on each individual ballot to wit:

CITY OF EXETER

Voters in California voted to impose state taxes on licenses cannabis businesses. Shall Ordinance No. 706 be enacted, imposing a local general tax on cannabis businesses at a rate not exceeding \$25 per square foot (annually adjusted by CPI) or 10% of gross receipts, to maintain public safety and general City services for Exeter residents; generating undetermined revenue until repealed?

The proposition shall require approval of a majority of the electorate voting on the tax.

Arguments for or against the general tax may be submitted to the Tulare County Registrar of Voters, 5951 South Mooney Blvd., Visalia, CA 93277, not later than August 2, 2022, which has been determined by the elections official to be a reasonable date based upon the time necessary to prepare and print arguments. No argument shall exceed 300 words in length.

Pursuant to Section 9281, 9282 and 9287 of the Elections Code, one argument for and one argument against each measure will be selected for printing and distribution to the voters with the sample ballot.

The elections official will also provide opportunity for rebuttal arguments, not to exceed 250 words, to be filed no later than August 12, 2022 in accordance with Section 9285 of the Elections Code.
