- 1. Demonstrated knowledge of existing disability programs to reach people with disabilities.
- 2. Background and/or experience using voting equipment, recognizing barriers to voter participation.
- 3. Experience in communications, training, web design, media, or social media.
- 4. Helpful experience in legal, advocacy, or policy backgrounds to assist with election related laws and policies.
