IMPARTIAL ANALYSIS BY COUNTY COUNSEL MEASURE Z

Article XIIID of the California Constitution authorizes a special district to levy assessments, provided that the proper procedures are followed and provided the assessment is approved by a two-thirds vote of the electorate residing in the district.

The Ivanhoe Public Utilities District proposes to establish a community street lighting project and has determined that the monthly assessment for a single family resident to fund the project will not exceed two dollars (\$2.00) per parcel per month.

The measures stated purpose is to establish a street lighting project and provide for the addition of 102 lights within the Ivanhoe Public Utility District.

The measure makes no change to existing law. The electors entitled to vote on this measure are the registered voters within the boundaries of the District. If the measure is not approved by at least two-thirds of the votes cast on the measure, the measure will fail and the assessment will not be implemented.
